FOREWORD

It has been ten years since my first opportunity to write a musical for Word Music & Church Resources! This musical is the third in a trilogy that started with that first musical, *Back to the Manger*. That musical followed the adventure of Norman and friends as they journeyed through time, eventually coming face to face with Jesus as He was born in a manger. Their lives, and the life of Henry Olson, the church custodian, were changed forever. *Back to the Cross* was the sequel to that musical, and found Norman, his sister Ava, and his young friend Finn on another adventure with the "H.O. 2000 Temporal Displacement Modulator." While journeying to see VBS events throughout the decades, they encountered great leaders in their church's history, realizing how changing the past could alter their church's future. Eventually, they went back to the Carden of Gethsemane and watched Jesus as He set His sights on the cross. Because of what lesus did on the cross, everything changed!

Back to the Beginning picks up a few years later, as Norman is the high school student eader of his church camping trip in the mountains. Ava is there, but Finn has fallen away from church and is hanging out with some questionable companions, the Rigsby brothers. As he and Pastor Henry Olson are leading the evening story time by the fire pit, Norman hears a familiar sound. He leaves the group and discovers Finn and the H.O. 2000! Finn shares that he had taken the time machine out to impress his new friends, but accidentally lost them in the Garden of Eden. Finn needs Norman's help to find the Rigsby brothers in the Garden of Eden before the space-time continuum is affected forever! The kids travel together through time, learning about creation in different time periods, ultimately going back to the Garden of Eden and talking about sin.

This musical addresses Finn's real questions about faith. Where is God when I'm hurting? Is God even real? His friends attempt to show Him God's love as he starts to slowly work through his questions while learning about each day of God's creation. These are important issues that our children face every day in a secular culture that is searching for truth and meaning in the world. May our students learn about God's love for them and His power and ultimate triumph over sin and death! It is my prayer that this musical will affect the lives of your kids forever for the Kingdom.

I am so thankful God has planted us at Village Church, Burbank. I deeply appreciate our pastor, Wade Mikels, who did a month-long Bible Study on Genesis this past year just to help me with the spiritual "meat" of this musical. Also, I am extremely excited to be working with my new drama

director, Eric Loomis who has numerous TV voice-over credits under his belt, and yet serves our kids with such knowledge and dedication. And always, the team at Word Music & Church Resources, specifically Dale Mathews, for their tireless input and support! On a personal note, my oldest son Nathaniel played the part of "Norman" for his first musical with me (on the CD, and also on stage), and asked if he could play the part again for his last musical with me, as he just graduated high school and is going off to college. Sniff. While I am sad to see him go in that respect, I am excited about his blossoming talents, especially since he helped me write two of the songs in this musical!

(At a campground in the mountains, centered around the rustic "Creation Café," Midway Community Church has taken a group of kids tent camping to explore God's creation.)

Back to the Beginning (God)

















(SFX—Accompaniment Track continues with Campfire Sounds)

(Lights come up on a large campsite in the mountains. A couple of tents are in the background, a fire pit is center stage. A children's group from Midway Community Church is roasting marshmallows, telling stories.)

NORMAN: Wasn't it a great day?

AVA: It sure was! I love seeing God's creation up close and personal!

MARISA: I'm a little better acquainted with those mosquitos than I'd like to

be. I have, like, 8 million mosquito bites.

OLIVIA: (dryly) Really. 8 million? (turns to PASTOR OLSON) How did you

like the hike to Diablo Canyon, Pastor Olson?

PASTOR OLSON: Ask these old legs tomorrow how they liked the like to Diablo

Canyon, although God's handiwork was exquisite: (gening up) Welp, that's it for me. There's a sleeping bag calling my name. Norman, why don't you lead the rest of the campfire time!

(PASTOR OLSON walks off stage, stiffly, making old-man-achy-grunt-sounds as

he leaves.)

NORMAN: With pleasure! On to my favorite part of the evening—

storytelling!

MARISA: Boring. Can we have our phones back now?

(KIDS agree.)

NORMAN: (taken aback) hat? No! You're going to want to hear this story.

Plus, we don't have any service out here.

OLIVIA: (startled, slowly scooting closer to Norman) Really? Then are we

safe? What if there are bears out here... (grabbing his arm) grizzly

bears?

(KIDS start talking.)

AVA: You guys! There aren't any bears! Just listen to my brother!

NORMAN Thank you, Ava. (politely trying to pry OLIVIA off of his arm) Ahem.

If I could direct your attention over here. I am going to share with

you something very few people know.

MARISA: (innocently) Why? Did you not post about it?

NORMAN: (frazzled) No, I didn't po— (sighs) It was a few years ago and Ava,

Finn, and I...

MARISA: Hey, why isn't Finn here?

(They ALL get distracted.)

OLIVIA: Finn?

MARISA: Finn Masterson.

AVA: I haven't seen him in a long time.

MARISA: (gossipy whisper) I heard Finn has been hanging out with the

Rigsby brothers.

NORMAN: (trying to regain their attention) People, people! Attention, please!

Epic storytime commencing! (pause)

A few years ago we went on the adventure of a lifetime.

MARISA: **Pics or it didn't happen.**

(KIDS giggle.)

NORMAN: (exasperated) Well, I didn't take any pictures! I only have a flip

phone!

MARISA: (incredulous) What?! What is even the point then?

(SFX—Camera Sound, Distant Time Machine, Can pfire Sounds cont.)

(MARISA starts taking pictures of herself posing in front of the campfire.)

NORMAN: Where did you get that? Hand it over

(MARISA gives him a death-look and hands over her phone. They stop talking, interrupted by a loud sound.)

NORMAN: No, no, no! It can't be! It snow that sound!

OLIVIA: It's a bear, isn't it? We're doomed!

NORMAN: (urgently) Everyone, stay tere. I'll go investigate.

(NORMAN walks to the side of the stage where he finds FINN, and the H.O. 2000 Time Machine)

NORMAN: Terrible turalish, Finn! What are you doing here? And why

are you using the time machine? After our last (air quotes)

"adventure," we agreed never to use it again!

FINN: I know, but I figured taking it out on a quick spin wouldn't hurt,

you know, for a good cause.

NORMAN What cause?

FINN: I... wanted to impress my new friends.

NORMAN: (knowingly) The Rigsby brothers?

FINN: Well, they were kinda making fun of me for not going along with

something they were doing, and so I... I kinda told them about the

machine.

NORMAN: Finnley. David. Masterson. You did not!

FINN: I know, but then they called me a liar and a baby, and then I just...

took them to see it.

NORMAN: That doesn't explain why you're here.

FINN: Right. So they were talking about evolution and the beginning of

time, and they wanted to go back—you know—to the beginning.

So I... I took them.

NORMAN: (confused) You took them? Then where are they?

FINN: Well, then I lost them...

NORMAN: (interrupting indignantly) You LOST them?

... in the Garden of Eden. FINN:

NORMAN: In the GARDEN OF EDEN!

MARISA: (walking up from behind a tree) What in the...

NORMAN: Terrible tunafish! Marisa, I told you to stay by the cam

(running over with hairspray in front of her) Is **OLIVIA:**

No! It's not a bear! It's a time machine! NORMAN:

(KIDS ooh and ah.)

(running over) Sorry, Norman, AVA: 't keep them there

anymore.

How in the world did you guys find this thing? Is it even safe? **OLIVIA:**

(walking into the time machine) It looks pretty cool. MARISA:

DVD3 (9) SFX—Control Panel Button Sounds)

Lots of (pushing buttons) buttons! MARISA:

Don't touch anything FINN:

Too late. Ooh! A little bit of artificial screen light... I miss my iPad. MARISA:

Marisa, this is not a toy. Please go back to the campfire. Ava, **NORMAN:**

Olivia, vou too.

HREE agree, grumbling, but instead of going back to the campfire, SA sweaks back into the time machine while NORMAN and FINN are

Finn, we have to go find them! Who knows what damage could be done to the space-time continuum if you leave the Rigsby brothers

in the Garden of EDEN!

(NORMAN steps into the machine and powers it on, not seeing MARISA crouching, hiding in the machine.)

PVP4 (10) (SFX—Time Machine 1)

NORMAN: I hope I don't regret this.

MARISA: (jumping out) Boo! I'm a bear! (laughs)

(OLIVIA screams.)

FINN: The machine is starting!

OLIVIA: I don't like the sound of this!

NORMAN: Marisa! Get out of the machine!

FINN: **Too late!**

(FINN helps OLIVIA and AVA into the machine quickly.)

NORMAN: It's already activated! Everyone, hold on! And here we gooooooo!

(Lights out.)

SCENE 2

(Lights come up on Creation Café, 1950s. A sign rays Creation Celebration 1955. The children walk out of the time machine.)

NORMAN: (looking around dubiously) This is not the Garden of Eden.

FINN: And definitely not the beginning of time. That's weird, I

programmed it in.

MARISA: (excited) Oh my gosh I wish I had my phone.

OLIVIA: Don't tell me I'm going to keep my eyes closed.

AVA: (sees two girls in poorle skirts) I am loving these skirts!

OLIVIA: (eyes sall closed) Skirts? Aren't we still in the mountains? Who

wears a skirt to go camping?

1950s GIRL: I've never seen you at the Creation Café. Want to come join us for

the sock hop?

MARISA: Sure!

(walking back to machine) I'm staying in the machine. Safer that way. Plus, if we're gonna be traveling in this thing, it really should be sanitized. Germs, you know. I'll just do a little deep cleaning.

(1950s GIRL walks off as MARISA waves.)

FINN: The time machine history queue is full... which means... well...

to put it simply: It's like an elevator. We are on the top floor, but Marisa just Jushed all the buttons, and we will have to stop at

each floor before we get to our destination...

MARISA, AVA & OLIVIA: ... the beginning.

NORMAN: The we better get going. We've got a lot of stops till we get to the

Garden of Eden! (He turns to power up the time machine.) Where's

Olivia?

SFX—Time Machine 2)

(OLIVIA sticks her arm out of the machine, waving the feather duster.)

MNN: Okay. Everyone in the machine. Let's gooooooo!

(Lights out.)

SCENE 3

(Lights come up. The year is 2000. Sign says "Creation Celebration 2000".)

AVA: Ooh! Looks like they're having a camp concert. It couldn't hurt to

listen for a minute, could it?

OLIVIA: I think it could. What if we start thinking low rise jeans are in

MARISA: Olivia, just live a little! This is so lit. I love the 2000s. The style is.

FINN: Whoa, bruh. Look at this guy's hair!

MARISA: Wigs. So. Many. Wigs.

NORMAN: While we are not at the beginning of time, we have traveled quite a

ways back.

AVA: I've never seen a tent like *that*!

OLIVIA: Are you sure they should have all those candles lit? In a forest?

FINN: It's night time. How else would they see?

NORMAN: In times before electricity, when the sun went lown, people went

to bed, although in this case, looks like they are having a party of

sorts.

GERTRUDE: (already in process) Just look abound a God's beautiful creation.

God spoke it into being. He speaks, and it happens.

GERTRUDE: (to BEETHOVEN, referring to the drums) What was all that

racket?!

BEETHOVEN: (semi-yelling because he's going deaf) **THE WHAT?**

GERTRUDE: That infernal noise during the second half of the song... like...

someone was dropping a beat!

BEETHOVEN: I DIDN'T HEAR ANYTHING. HOW DID YOU LIKE MY NEW

PIECE? IT'S STILL A WORK IN PROGRESS...

(They start walking off stage.)

GERTRUDE: It could use some work... I'm not 100% sure about the lyrics...

maybe you could write something more joyful...

BEETHOVEN: (said really quickly) JOYFUL?

(They exit.)

AVA: So, Finn, where *have* you been lately?

FINN: I just... life has gotten more complicated. There's a lot of drama at

home, and honestly, I've started wondering if God is real.

AVA: (surprised, but trying not to show it) Really!?

FINN: I know that's not what I'm supposed to say, as a "good Christian,"

but, tell me this, if God was real, why wouldn't He fix it? Isn't He all-powerful? I was always told that God loved me, but now I'm

not so sure.

AVA: Oh, Finn, I'm so sorry. Thank you for trusting me enough to share

with me. I know that God does love you, but I understand that

right now it doesn't feel like it.

NORMAN: Sorry to interrupt, but it's time to go!

(ALL gather in the machine.)

NORMAN: (don't have to convince him) We may as well, and we're already

here. And maybe they have an extra pair of skates for me.

(NORMAN exits and quickly puts on skates.)

days of creation. And now, we ve come to our last day. The Bible

says that after God worked. He rested.

(Music begins for "The Sevents Day"

JENNY: By doing this, God set a moder for us so that His people would

know to spend a seventh of their time in rest and restoration.

(During song, NORMAN comes out on roller skates.)

AVA: Hey, Finn, do you have a minute to talk?

AVA: I was thinking about what you said—how when bad things happen

it's hard to trust that God loves us. Our feelings can lead us in many different directions. But our feelings also can be to us. What you *feel* isn't solid, but *truth* is. Truth matters. We know that God is the Ruler over all, but He also gave man free will, and in the Garden of Eden, man made the wrong choice. He went with

feelings over truth.

(DAVID MASTERSON walk up to join mem.)

DAVID: I couldn't help but overhear you. Hey, I'm David. Did I hear you

talking about the Garden of Eden?

FINN: (deadpan) No.

DAVID: Well, this is awkward.

FINN: (smiling) Just kidding, bruh.

DAVID: Excellent, high five! (They high five.) But anyway, that's what we've

been studying in our Bible lessons this week. You know, I'd heard it all before, but this week somehow it's really hit home. The Bible says Satan is crafty and tricky. He challenges God's authority. He

gets us to question God.

AYA: But he appears like he's on our side.

DAVID: Yes! The Bible says Satan appears as light, bright and shining, but

is really a slithering ugly snake.

QLIVIA: (shudder) Snakes—not-so-fun fact, did you know that 25% of

snakes are poisonous!

EVE: Yes, you. Can you help me tie the back of this dress?

OLIVIA: **Stranger danger!** (runs away)

MARISA: Let me help you... (ties dress)

EVE: (looking around nervously) I think I did something I shouldn't have.

There was this tree, with these really great apples, and we weren't supposed to touch them, but they looked so yummy, so I took one, and then I gave one to Adam. And now... things are different.
