(Stage is dark, except for a spotlight on CHLOE, standing center.)

Praystation

(Spotlight widens a bit to light a chair, and CHLOE'S little brother, WYATT.)

PHLOE: **That's it. I've beat every game, and I'm bored.** (She plops down, poutting.)

WYATT: Chloe, for the one billionth time—try out my game! (He offers her the VR glasses.)

HLOE: Oh, sweetie. I'm a real gamer. Your game is... (skeptical) about prayer.

WYATT: I'm telling you, you won't regret it.

CHLOE: Bro, mixing God and video games isn't done. Plus, everyone knows how to pray.

WYATT: This game's special. Come on!





(CHLOE reluctantly puts on the VR glasses. She looks around in wonder and sees the choir, and characters from the game, all singing and moving around them.)





(MOM walks in with laundry in basket. They take off virtual reality glasses. Every other person in the video game drops to ground. Lights dyn.)

MOM: Chloe, will you please unload the dishwasher?

CHLOE: (a bit spicy) Mom, I'm busy.

MOM: I thought I just heard you say you were bored.


CHLOE: No, I'm. playing the... (falsely cheerful) best new game.

(MOM smiles at her and walks off.)

WYATT: (smiling, teasing) Best, huh?

CHLOE: (throwing up her hands) I'll check it out...

(WIATT and CHLOE put on the glasses, and the game swirls to life around them again.)









SCENE 2

Boogie Board Beach

(Lights up. There are sandcastles, beach towels, and boogie boards spread out on stage.)

CHLOE: Okay, you got me. It's better than doing dishes, I suppose. I do like the virtual reality

aspect. These glasses we're wearing make it feel like I'm actually on a beach!

(CHLOE goes immediately into game mode, quickly walking around, looking for clues.)

WYATT: Yep, this is Level 1—Boogie Board Beach!

CHLOE: (already running around in circles) When you're a serious gamer, you need to immediately

assess the landscape when you get in a game. Wasting early minutes can be devastating.

(She poses, ready to fight.) Who am I fighting first?

WYATT: Well, you're not so much fighting...

CHLOE: (deflated) **Terrific.**

WYATT: Just wait! It's fun! But I'm not going to spoil anything for you—I want you to enjoy the

game.

AV12 10 (Music begins for "Sneaky Cowboy Rap")

WYATT: Uh oh, here comes the Sneaky Cowboy!

(The SNEAKY COWBOY enters, moving slyly to the muste.)

Song: Sneaky Cowboy Rap

(SNEAKY COWBOY dance-slinks off.)

CHLOE: Ooh, that's what I'm talking about. A side quest. Oh, there's a *Crabby Coin* hanging over there!

(CHLOE sees a token hanging of a branch of a tree or set piece. She grabs it.)

(Optional SFX: 93 Crabby Coin)

(CHLOE starts circling around searching for the tokens, gathering some up in her arms. They are placed around on the ground or hanging by fishing wire.)

PRAYSTATION PACEX: Surf's up, Praystationers! Cowabunga! (He does an over-the-top gesture that will be repeated each time he says "Cowabunga.")

CHLOE: Ooh, another Crabby Coin!

(Optional SFX: 93 Crabby Coin)

CHLOE: You'll journey through levels on the way to Victory Summit...

WYATT: (to CHLOE) Try not to get distracted with side quests!

(announcer like) Level 1: Boogie Board Beach! The first obstacle you'll face is the Cranky Crabs.

(Music begins for "Hallowed Be Your Name")

PACEY: Your objective is to put sunglasses on ten crabs* without getting pinched. (hands them a basket of sunglasses) Good luck and... Cowabunga! (* If you are using less than ten crabs, adjust the number.)

(CHLOE walks around during the first part of song, gathering Crabby Coins.)

Song: Hallowed Be Your Name

Hallowed Be Your Name







CHLOE: Have I missed the Cranky Crabs? I'm ready with the sunglasses!

WYATT: Oh, you'll know them when you see them!





CHLOE: Excuse me! Who talks like that, "hallowed?"


WYATT: (shrugs) "Hallowed" just means we praise God for His holiness.


PACEY: Cowabunga! Watch out! You'll get pushed back to the checkpoint if you get pinched!

Here... come... the... CRABS!

(SMALL KIDS come swirling out around them with their pinchers in the air, crab-walking sideways)
(CHLOE and WYATT try to put sunglasses on 10 of them, or the number designated.)








(CRAB "pinches" CHLOE.)

CHLOE: Ouch! I got pinched!



(The CRABS quickly exit, taking off sunglasses backstage, and CHLOE and WYATT spin, with arms flailing, back to where they were when the crabs first came out.)



PACEY. Cowabunga! Watch out! You'll get pushed back to the checkpoint if you get pinched! Here... come... the... CRABS!

(CHLOE and WYATT again try to put sunglasses on 10 of them, or the number designated.)









SCENE 3

Salty Sea

AV14 (22) (SFX: Level 1 Complete)

PACEY: Congratulations! You've completed Level 1 and earned your boogie boards! Cowabunga!

(PACEY awards them with the boogie boards.)

DUDETTE: (running up and posing while she says her catch phrase) Hang loose, dudes!

DUDE: (walking up with DUDETTE, carrying a surfboard) (posing) Gotta catch those waves!

DUDETTE: Dude, you've learned the first piece of the Prayer!

DUDE: Righteous! (having an idea) Dude! Let's all say it together.

(He leads out and everyone joins in.)

ALL: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name!

DUDE: You just learned about God's Name being seriously holy, dude.

DUDETTE: In Bible times, some thought His name was so totally holy they didn't always even say it

aloud!

DUDE: (whispering, like "wow") **Dude.**

DUDETTE: (nodding affirmatively, like "I know!") Dude

DUDE: But like, sometimes we totally forget how big Godd's and we think we know better than

Him.

DUDETTE: (wistfully, like "How sad") Dude.

DUDE: (agreeing, like "I know") Dude!

WYATT: (under his breath to CALOF Sometimes these characters get caught in a "dude" loop.

They have a whole conversation just with the word "dude."

DUDETTE: (questioning) Dude?

DUDE: (answering) Dude!

DUDETTE: (having an great idea) Dude!

DUDE: (thinking) Dude.

DUDETTE: (whispering) Bude.

BOTH: (excited) DUDE!!!

WYATT: It's oddly mesmerizing.

ÇHLOE: (tapping them) Excuse me. Can we move on?

WYATI: (cautiously) **Dude?**

DUDE: Get ready to hop on your boards, dudes, and follow us out into the Salty Sea.

DODETTE: Your quest is to find the *Dancing Dolphin* dude. He will give you the instructions for the

next part of the adventure!

DUDE: Gotta catch those waves! (They grab their boards and sing.)








DUDETTE: Time to dive down deep, dudes!

CHLOE and WYATT: Woah!!



(Blue stage lights. EVERYONE starts swimming in slow motion underwater. They swim slowly around CHOIR members who hold pieces of seaweed. The DUDES swim up, having a conversation.)

DUDE: (exclaiming, looking around) **Dude!**

DUDETTE: (agreeing) Dude.

DUDE: (question and point over to side) **Dude?**

DUDETTE: (sure) **Dude.** (They swim off.)

(CHLOE swims up to a KID holding a stick with a colorful fish on it.)

CHLOE: Have you seen the Dancing Dolphin?

FISH: He's over there!


(He points up at screen where a dolphin is dancing and instructions are written. Option: If not using the Accompaniment Video, have a child in a dolphin costume say the Dancing Dolphin line.)

WYATT: The Dancing Dolphin says, "You've made it through the Salty Sea. Now, catch the wave back to shore."

CHLOE: (reading) Drop the board and wait for my friend in the Disco Desert.


WYATT: Catch the wave!

(Blue stage lights turn off. The KIDS stop "swimming" underwater.)














SCENE 4

Disco Desert

(DISCO CACTUS, LITTLE CACTUS 1, 2, and 3 enter and freeze across the stage, with their arms up in a cactus shape, facing the back wall. A sign says "Welcome to Disco Desert.")

AV (6 31) (SFX: Level 2 Complete)

WYATT: (putting the boogie board down) I love that dolphin. He cracks me up! And, we learned the

next piece of the prayer.

CHLOE: (flatly) Let me guess. We say it together.

WYATT: **Always!** (He leads everyone.)

ALL: Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

CHLOE: Looks like we've made it to the desert. Now we just need to find the delphin's friend.

(CHLOE walks around asking choir members, or inanimate set pieces.)

CHLOE: Are you friends with a dolphin? (KIDS shake their head no.) Are YOU friends with a

dolphin?

SNEAKY COWBOY: (coaxes CHLOD off to side) Pst! Hey, pardner! I know how you can skip this level.

CHLOE: How?

SNEAKY COV BOY: If you pile all up all your Crabby Coins on top of that cactus over there, (pointing

offstage) you warp up to Level 4.

CHLOE Uh, yes, please!

WYATT: (trying to help without telling her what to do) The dolphin did say to wait for his friend...

CHLOE: Maybe this is his friend. (to the Cowboy) Are you friends with a dolphin?

(Sneaky Cowboy underscore ends.)

SVEAKY: (pause, clearly lying) Uhhh! Sure.

CHLOE: (to WYATT) See! I'm skipping it.

(CHLOE runs off to side of stage with her pile of Crabby Coins. She is no longer in the scene, but remains on stage, facing the side of stage, with her head down. DISCO CACTUS unfreezes and turns around, carrying two cactus sticks.)

DISCO CACTUS: (to WYATT) (posing) Welcome to the Disco Desert. Your mission is to boogie down with these cactus sticks—chopping the food when it passes by. But take care not to chop a tumbleweed. That would be chaos city and reset your score to 0!

WYATT: Got it! (He takes the two sticks from DISCO CACTUS.)

DISCO CACTUS: Wasn't there another player?

WYATT: Yeah, my sister Chloe. It's her first time playing the game, and she's been delayed by the

Sneaky Cowboy.

DISCO CACTUS: Ahh, the Sneaky Cowboy. That's a bit of a prickle!

DISCO CACTUS: (pleased at her joke) A prickle, get it? Woo! Do the Desert Disco!

(All CACTI do disco arm moves while moving in a circle.)

(Desert Disco Underscore ends)

DISCO CACTUS. In the desert we learn how to ask God to provide for us—to give us our daily bread.

AV Q 34 (Music begins for "What's the Goal?")

DISCO CACTUS: Ooh, feel the funk, get down and get ready to chop!

(As music starts, DISCO CACTUS, LITTLE CACTUS 1, 2, and 3 do disco poses.)

Song: What's the Goal?

(During chorus, the food starts to whiz by on the vides, WYATT and DISCO CACTUS chop through the air with cactus sticks. Option: If not using the Accompaniment Video, simply have WYATT and DIANA use the sticks to slice through the air.)













Rodeo Range

AV(10 43 (SFX: Level 3 Complete)

DISCO CACTUS: Cactilaxin! You jiving yet? You've learned the next piece of the Prayer. Let's say it together.

ALL: Give us this day our daily bread.

DISCO CACTUS: When things get prickly, just remember—God will provide what we need for EACH day. Remember this *Power Up Password*. You'll need it later. When you're asked "What's the goal? What's the goal?" You say... (points to LITTLE CACTUS)

LITTLE CACTUS 1: (talk/singing) To daily trust in Him.

DISCO CACTUS: (rhythmically) What's the goal? What's the goal?

LITTLE CACTUS 2: To rest in His love!

(ALL clap and cheer.)

DISCO CACTUS: I'll let you in on a secret: did you know that prayer isn't just to get something from God? It's far bigger than that.

LITTLE CACTUS 3: I'm on pins and needles!

DISCO CACTUS: Prayer is not the means to an end, dramatically) in many ways, it is the end itself.

LITTLE CACTUS 1,2,3: Ooooh!

(CHLOE comes back on with Band Aids on her arms and face and hair messy.)

WYATT: Chloe, what happened?

CHLOE: (with attitude) Well, I supe didn't skip a level.

WYATT: **Obviously.**

CHLOE: In fact, I had a run in with a cactus.

WYATT: **Ooh, no...**

CHLOE: When I tried to climb up the cactus... to put the Crabby Coins on top, it... didn't like

that.

DISCO CACTUS: (smiling) We rarely do. Sounds like you listened to the wrong voice. You'll want to watch out for that—especially once you reach the *Temptation Trail*.

CHLOE: It seemed like good advice.

DISCO CACTUS: Another reason why it's important to learn how to talk to God and hear His voice. Sometimes—it's hard to tell who is telling us the truth! Prayer keeps us in constant communion with God, which is the goal of our entire believing lives.

LITTLE CACTUS 1: Romans 12:12, Be joyful in hope, ...

IXTTLE CACTUS 2: ... patient in affliction, ...

LITTLE CACTUS 3: ... faithful in prayer!

DISCO CACTUS: That's right, little Cacti. Lookin' sharp!

DISCO CACTUS: Get it? Sharp? Woo! Do the Desert Disco!

(Desert Disco Underscore ends)

DISCO CACTUS: But now, we've come to the end of the desert! Catch ya on the flip side.

(DISCO CACTUS and CACTI leave stage.

(From stage right, COWBOYS start sidestepping in to the left, in straight lines. No one turns their back or walks forward. WYATT and CHLOG suddenly start side stepping left and right, not walking or kicking forward to towards audience.)

RODEO REBA: Yeeehawww! Welcome to the Rodeo Range.

WYATT: It's the old-school level! I love this one!

CHLOE: Woah, what's happening? Why can I only step sideways?

AV 112 45 (Music begins for "This Is My Prayer")

WYATT: It's called a platformer level. You can only move and jump side to side.

RODEO REBA: Remember, watch out for the lassos!

(During chorus, KIDS dressed as COWBOYS do a routine with brown "lassos" made of hula hoops. CHLOE and WYATT do the step, step routine, waiting for the HULA HOOP PEOPLE to move so they can move sideways. The HULA HOOP PEOPLE move up and back as an obstacle.)









Temptation Trail

AV (13 65) (SFX: Level 4 Complete)

RODEO REBA: Yeeeehawwww! You've made it through the *Rodeo Range* and learned the next piece of the Prayer. Let's say it together.

ALL: And forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors*.

RODEO REBA: As y'all know, a debt means the sins we all commit. Everyone sins, and everyone needs the forgiveness of God. But too many times we receive forgiveness from God, but then we don't give that very same forgiveness to others.

LITTLE COWBOY: ... Like the guy in the Bible whose master forgave him all that money

WYATT: And then he went and threw someone else in jail for owing him a few pennies!

RODEO REBA: (shrug) It's like drinking poison. Most folks don't realize that unforgiveness is like poison to the soul! Forgiveness is just the medicine we need. Now, I hope y'all are ready, because where you're headed next is the most treacherous of all. The *Temptation Trail*.

ALL: (ominously) **Ooooh.**

RODEO REBA: This level is completely dark!

CHLOE: Completely dark?

RODEO REBA: (handing them a small glowstick) Take care not to get distracted by voices that may lead you into traps. Once you make it to the *Checkpoint*, say the *Power-Up Password* and you will be rewarded with a candle to light your way. Happy trails! Yeeehaw! (She walks offstage.)

AV 114 56 (Music begins for "Watch and Pray")

(Lights fade. CHOIR sits down and VARIOUS KIDS put on glow stick bracelets and necklaces.)
(Stage lights turn completely off)

Song: Watch and Pray

SNEAKY COWBOY: (wearing glow-in-the-dark cowboy hat) Pst! Hey, pardner! I know a shortcut to the end of the trail.

CHLOE: Uh? Is this the checkpoint? I thought there were supposed to be candles.

SNEAKY COWBOY: Nah. But you can level up by taking this shortcut.


CHLOE: Sounds great to me! (She follows SNEAKY COWBOY offstage.)











(TREE OF LIGHT enters and stands on corner of stage.)

TREE OF LIGHT: Greetings! You've reached the *Tree of Light*! In the book of John, Jesus said, "I am the light of the world! He who follows me will not walk in darkness but will have the light of life!" (John 8:12)

Now, it's Power-Up Password time! (said in rhythm) What's the goal? What's the goal?

WYATT: To daily trust in Him.

TREE OF LIGHT: Excellent! Take this candle to light your way.

WYATT: (taking the candle) Thanks! Except, I have to go back and get Chloe. She doesn't know the Power-Up Password, and she's gonna be in trouble.

(CHOIR passes out candles and lights them as they sing, until the whole stage is lit with candles.)







(CHLOE is standing (or sitting) behind a set piece so it appears that she is in a pit. The SNEAKY COWBOY walks up and sits nearby, watching her struggle.)


CHLOE: Hey, Cowboy, help me out! I seem to be stuck in a loop. The tree kept asking me, "What's the goal? What's the goal?" I couldn't figure out the answer, and it re-routed me over here in this pit.


SNEAKY COWBOY: Sure. The goal of prayer is—it's about making your life better. When you pray, you can have God do anything you want.

(Song pauses)

CHLOE: I already tried saying that. It didn't let me cross the checkpoint, and I got re-routed to this pit. Now I'm still here... going in circles. (frustrated) Ugh! This game is the worst! Who makes a whole video game about prayer?

WYATT: (calling from across the stage) Chloe! There you are!





(Song starts again)

CHLOE: Hey! That's my brother! I'm over here! Help!

SNEAKY COWBOY: You can do this on your own. Prayer is useless. (He walks away.)

WYATT: Don't listen to that! Those are lies! God can lead us when things are dark. We just need to daily trust in Him. That's the goal! Grab the rope—I'll pull you out! Pull!

(WYATT pulls CHLOE out and sings.)





(Lights come up on stage right. PRAYSTATION PACEY greets WYATT. CHLOE is offstage left.)

AV 116 68 (SFX: Level 5 Complete)

PRAYSTATION PACEY: Congratulations! You've completed the Temptation Trail and learned the next piece of the Prayer. Let's say it.

ALL: Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

DUDE: None of us can avoid temptation, dude. And we all walk through situations that are dark.

But we don't need to be afraid, for we have a Father that walks with us and is totally

more powerful than evil.

DISCO CACTUS: We can pray God delivers us and gives us wisdom to boogie away from temptation.

(discouraged) I'm bad at this game. I didn't run away from temptation, and I got stuck in CHLOE:

a pit.

DUDETTE: Dude, without God's wisdom, it's totally easy to wipeout and wake up in a pit.

DUDE: Yeah, dude.

DUDETTE: That's why it's so important to listen to God's voice and ask for His guidance, dudes. We

learn to recognize His voice by chillin' in His Word, dudes, and spending time listening to

Him.

You all are so excited about prayer. But prayer... it doesn't... it doesn't... never mind. CHLOE:

WYATT: That's okay. What were you going to say?

CHLOE: It doesn't work. You remember when Grandma was sick last year. I prayed for her to get

better in time to see me in the playoffs. And she didn't.

(gently) She did get better. WYATT:

CHLOE: But not in time to see me play in the tournament! And I prayed she'd get better for it.

RODEO REBA: God doesn't always answer our prayers the way we think He will. He DOES want to bless

us, but more than that, He wants us to KNOW Him and run to Him in hard times.

DISCO CACTUS: He alone is able to rescue us from the darkness. That's why our goal is to daily trust in

Him and to rest in His love.

(Music begins for "It's All About You") AV 17 69

CHLOE: Maybe... I don't know how to pray.

WYATT: Phis is the perfect place to learn.

PRAY STATI NRACEY: The Lord's Prayer begins and ends with God and God alone. His name. His kingdom. His power. His glory. By fixing our eyes on Him, we learn what really matters, and everything else levels up.

(CHLOE walks toward front of stage to sing.)

Victory Summit

AV 18 (Music begins for "Victory Summit Underscore")

PACEY: Congratulations! You've arrived at Victory Summit!

ALL: (Cheer!)

DUDETTE: On Level 1, we learned to praise God's name. He is holy, dude!

WYATT: And in Level 6, we learned that God is worthy of praise forever.
