

A Wooly Awesome Christmas
































SCENE 2

(PAX comes out center stage in a spotlight.)

PAX: Sure. Every sheep celebrates Christmas *now*, but just a few years ago, it was a different story. I remember it like it was yesterday...

(Lights come up on an open field in Bethlehem on a starry night. Upstage left there is a large rock. Three SHEEP walk on from stage right, calling back offstage stage right, presumably to MARY and JOSEPH, who are not seen. PAX joins them from center stage.)

AV 12 (1) (SFX: Time Sequence and Pasture Background)

TRIXIE: Bye now. You two get some rest!

RAMI: As much as a young couple with a baby CAN get when they re

surrounded by animals... in a stable.

MIMI: You have a very lovely home—I mean... stable.

PAX: We really appreciate the invitation, folks

TRIXIE: You all go ahead, I need to check my hair There's some

unexpected moisture in the air tought—not good for my wool-do.

(TRIXIE walks over down stage left and leans over a "pond," checking her wool-do.)

MIMI: Trixie, you know your wool-do is the envy of *all* the sheep in Bethlehem.

(TRIXIE flashes a smile back at her. MIMI sees JERRY THE GOAT cross upstage left, wandering)

Hey, Pax, isn't that Jerry over there?

TRIXIE: (disdain) Oh... the yelling goat?

PAX: Yest Where is his herd? (calling out) You okay, Jerry?

12 (SFX Jerry the Goat)

(JNRY Just opens his mouth and pantomimes yelling.)

PAX: (awkward) Well. That's nice. Good luck finding your herd, Jerry.

(JERRY continues to wander around upstage, while the four SHEEP stand center stage and talk. A blue light is suddenly illuminated from behind the rock.)

AMI: What a night. Not every night you see angels! The statistical

probability is .00000...

MIMI: (cutting him off) Hey, guys, what's with that blue light behind the

rock over there? (She points across, upstage to side.)

TRIXIE: (squinting that direction and feeling grumpy) If that's more angels

singing "Gloria," I don't think I can handle it. I mean, it was

great. But how much "Gloria" can you hear? It is now FAR past

my bedtime. Seven hours to be exact!

PAX: Better leave it alone. The shepherd should be back any minute.

RAMI: (simply can't resist) That's not naturally occurring on this field. I

have to check it out.

(RAMI walks over towards rock, intrigued, and oblivious to what PAX is saying.)

PAX: (throwing hands up in the air) It's like I'm not even here.

TRIXIE: (calling back at him) If the rock starts singing "Gloria," just ignore

it!

PAX: Sheeple. I'm going to have to put my hoof down...

(SFX: Time Poof 1)

(Suddenly there is a loud sound, a flash of light, and RAM) disappears behind rock or stage wall. MIMI walks over to investigate.)

MIMI: (shocked) He's gone!

TRIXIE: What do you mean, gone?

(TRIXIE walks over to where he was, curious.)

MIMI: He was right here, behind this rock

(SFX: Time Poof 2)

(There is a flash of light and TRIXIE also disappears behind the rock.)

PAX: (looks around with concern and confusion) Mimi? Where'd she go? (PAX notices with growing alarm that TRIXIE is walking towards the rock, almost in a sance.)

Trixie, stay away from the blue light. I mean it!

TRIXIE: (drawn toward the light) I don't want to follow them, but I feel... compelled...

15 (SFX: Time Poof 3)

(TRIXIE disappears into the blue light.)

Aaaand... she stepped into the light. (sigh) This is what I get for delaying my retirement. (sigh) Okay, I'm coming, sheeple. I'm a mutton for punishment.

(SFX: Time Poof 4)

(PAX walks into the light and disappears. JERRY walks right after him into the light. He disappears behind the rock and there is a blackout.)

(BLACKOUT)

(Lights come up on a soundstage in 1997. There is a sign that says "Celebration Studios" and a director sitting in a director's chair. The four SHEEP are on all fours, center stage, looking around themselves in confusion. JERRY stands back behind the SHEEP so that he's not really seen. They do not notice him. ACTORS and CAMERAMEN move about.)

AV (3 (SFX: Celebration Studios Background 1)

MIMI: (looking around) Wowww! This is a HUGE STABLE.

TRIXIE: How did we get back to the stable? Did I black out? How's my

hair?

RAMI: (looking offstage) Wait, where's the field? And the animals? This is

extraordinary!

(AD with a headset/clipboard walks up to SHEEP.)

AD: (to the DIRECTOR, who is looking down at clipboard and not paying

attention) Dude! Score! Who shelled out the dough to get REAL

sheep for the nativity?!

(SFX: Jerry the Goat)

(JERRY just opens his mouth and pantomimes yelling.)

AD: (even more excited) Woah! And a GOAT?!

FLY ANGEL: That's so fly...

AD: I'm totally buggin. The hudget on this filming just went way up!

DIRECTOR: (briskly, no neasense) Just put them in the scene. (shouting) Alright,

everybody! Starting chearsal of the Finale!

(During the song, MARY and JOSEPH are featured in the stable with baby Jesus. EVERYONE's singing and happy.)



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SCENE 3

(The SHEEP are still looking around with interest. RAMI is preoccupied looking at a large book labeled "CCM of the 1990s")

AV (5 (SFX: Celebration Studios Background 2)

DIRECTOR: CUT! That's a cut on the Finale rehearsal!

PAX: (cawling up to AD politely) Excuse me, sir, we seem to have lost ou

pasture. Can you point me toward Bethlehem field?

AD: 'Sup, little sheep? (ruffles his head) Baa, baa to you too, little

buddy!

RAMI: I don't think they understand our language! Fascinating

MIMI: What's going on, Pax?

PAX: I don't know yet. Just try to blend in.

TRIXIE: I'm exhausted. I'm going to take a standing nap.

(TRIXIE closes her eyes, tweaks her head to the side and freezes. She doesn't notice that JERRY has walked up behind her)

MIMI: (whispers) It's so weird how she can do that.

(SFX: Jerry the Goat)

(JERRY just opens his mouth and pantonimes yelling.)

TRIXIE: (jumps) Oh, my heepness Jerry!

DIRECTOR: Mary, come forward more with baby Jesus.

AD: Oh oh. maybe hold Him up like in that movie that just came

out—the cartoon...

FLY ANGEL: Lon King! That's so fly!

DIRECTOR: Great—hold him up Lion King style!

FANCY MARY: Copy that!

(MARY and JOSEPH lift up baby Jesus towards the sky with straight arms as DRECTOR looks through camera.)

Sheeple, I don't think we are in Bethlehem anymore.

RAMI: Definitely another pasture—maybe even another land!

(RAMI holds up the book that says "CCM of the 1990s.")

Look, I found some weird sort of scroll. It's flat, with multiple pages. Amazing! (He opens the book and starts reading.)

TRIXIE: Wait... That's not Mary and Joseph! We just saw them.

PAX: But why would someone impersonate that poor couple from the

stable?

MIMI: Who knows? But these people are fancier. And the shepherd smells

different.

RAMI: This scroll I found should help us. It's called *CCM of the 1990s*. By

D.C. Talk and Michael W. Smith.

PAX: Many initials. Sounds official. What does it say?

RAMI: (reading) It seems they want to be called "Jesus. Freaks."

MIMI: (confused) Jesus... Freaks? Really!

TRIXIE: "Jesus"? Like the Baby that was born in Bethlehem tonight?

RAMI: Yes... (adding) Ooh... And they never want to be in the dark

PAX: (intrigued) Really! (pointing up) Maybe that's why there's all this

artificial sunlight... (proud of his discovery) They are afraid of the

dark!

RAMI: That does add up. The scroll says, "I wanna be in the light!"

(TRIXIE crawls right up to MARY, who is sitting down, looking in a small mirror and fixing her makeup.)

TRIXIE: Excuse me, fancy, fake Mary I feel like if anyone would have a

hairbrush, it would be your Your locks are truly gorgeous.

FANCY MARY: (jumps back in disgust, thooly) Augh! There is a real sheep in the

studio! And it just got up in my face! As if!

TRIXIE: (shocked) I've been standing next to you for five minutes, and

you're just seeing me now? (sighs) Typical! Listen, Fancy Mary,


sheep are wook awesome. Let's break it down for her.

(MARY looks at them as an oddity but is only interested for a while.)

AV 16 28 Song: Sheep Stuff

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AV (*LOOP*: *Celebration Studios Background*)

(The SHEEP pose, hoping for a response from FANCY MARY, which doesn't come.)

TRIXIE: (still hopeful for a response) **How'd you like that, Fancy Mary?**

FANCY MARY: (disdain) I love these sheep—NOT!

TRIXIE: (deadpan) I don't get it. Does she love me or not?

MIMI: Trixie, she doesn't understand what we're saying. You can say

anything you want! Watch this!

(MIMI walks up to a SHEPHERD.)

Mr. Shepherd, WHY DON'T YOU SMELL?

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: (clearly understands her) I DON'T KNOW And THAT'S KIND OF RUDE!

ALL: (GASP!)

(SHEEP all look out at audience, shocked, and then EVERYONE talks at once!)

RAMI: ... Did he just understand vou?

PAX: ... That was unexpected

MIMI: ... Uhhhhhhhhh. Just kidding

TRIXIE: ... I am totally sheeping out!

(All SHEEP circle around each other in a panic.)

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: (landly) Take a chill pill! I've understood animals all my

life. It's my gift.

TRIXIE: New 2HIS... is new.

MIMI: (so embarrassed) Mr. Shepherd, I am a big fan of shepherds, and I

would like to sincerely apologize...

DIRECTOR (walking center stage) Attention! Positions for Scene 3!

AD: (motioning towards the sheep) Someone corral the sheep—they're

wandering.

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: I'll take care of it!

(to the SHEEP) Come over here, little dudes. See that thing he's holding? It's a camera and will be documenting your every move

for the world to see!

TRIXIE: The world? What a day to forget my wool-brush!

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: You look great! Just stand here and smile.

(CAMERAMAN moves to a position to film the SHEEP, ANGELS, and SHEPHERDS. SCOTT THE SHEPHERD stands behind the sheep and smiles in a pose for the camera.)

DIRECTOR: (clapping) Last looks. Picture's up.

AD: (holding clapper) Awesome Christmas Celebration Scene 3! And...

action!

NARRATOR 1: "And there were shepherds living out in the fields nearby, keeping watch over their flocks at night. An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were

terrified.

AV17 (Music begins for "Hallelujah, Sing Glory")

NARRATOR 2: But the angel said to them, 'Do not be afraid. Libring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord." (Luke 2:8-11 NIV)

Song: Hallelujah, Sing Glory with Hark! the Herald Angels Sing

(Throughout the song, the CAMERAMAN should slowly move in front of the cast members, "filming" them for the movie He can kneel down center stage right and left, with his back to the audience and film the actors on stage.)

AV (*LOOP*: *Celebration Studios Background*)

DIRECTOR: That was great, guys. Reset cameras. We are moving on to the next

scene!

AD: Reset!

(CAMERAMAN moves to opposite side of the stage and consults with DIRECTOR. Meanwhile, RAMI gathers the three other SHEEP together and opens the book.)

RAMI: Okay, sheeple, I learned more from the scroll. These humans

always need to be heading west. Oh, and stay very young See?

MIMI: (reading over his shoulder) Go west. Young man.

AD: (motioning to SCOTT THE SHEPHERD) You, shepherd. Please

move the sheep over there. Have them tuck in behind the angels.

(SCOTT THE SHEPHERD starts to signal them over to other side, behind the ANGELS.)

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: My bad!

TRIXIE: (pointing at the ANGEL and realizing) Angels! That's who they are!

With the fake wings... I thought they were pretending to be birds!

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: Come over here, sheep!

RAMI: (confused, even as he is secoting over) But that's east. I thought we

were only supposed go west. This is very confusing.

TRIXIE: Perhaps should be standing closer to the camera—my stage

presence and all.

(TRIXIE moves to the front of the group, near baby Jesus and smiles at the camera.)

MIMI: (siding up to SHEPHERD) Hey, Jesus Freak.

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: (surprised) What did you call me?!

Embarrassed, MIMI puts her head in her hands and runs away.)

MMI: Baa baa baa baa baa... (fading away)

MRECTOR: Let's go! Scene 4. Camera set on the manger!

(CAMERAMAN moves to a kneeling position, just to the side of the manger.)

FANCY MARY: Oh, look, that strange sheep is sniffing the baby Jesus!

TRIXIE: (horrified) What? I am doing nothing of the kind!

DIRECTOR: Quick, let's get a close up of that sheep, kind of like, ...

AV 18 42 (Music begins for "Asleep on the Hay")


DIRECTOR: ... "Even the animals are wondering what this Jesus is all about."

And... action!

TRIXIE: (confused, with sudden stage fright) What? What's going on?

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: Sing, little sheep! Sing!

(TRIXIE abruptly starts singing a solo, starting out shy, but quickly becoming at home on stage.)



















AV (*LOOP*: *Celebration Studios Background*)

MIMI: Just what IS this place?

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: Hey, homeskillet, this is *Celebration Studios*. I couldn't

help but overhear you. We are making a movie about the true meaning of Christmas. (SHEEP just stare at him blankly.) You

know, Christmas? Birth of Jesus?

PAX: (acting like he understands) **Oh, yes. That Baby.**

FANCY MARY: (walking up with disdain) Um. Are you talking to the sheet

Whatever. (She walks away.)

RAMI: Can I ask... Who is the reigning king?

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: (confused, but trying to help) Well, there's. Burger King?

RAMI: I'm afraid we are a long way from home.

PAX: Does your flat scroll say anything about how to get home?

RAMI: (trying to be positive) Other than going west?

PAX: (not amused) Other than going west.

RAMI: Then, no.

DIRECTOR: Hey, guys? Let's get a shot of the three Wise Men coming in.

(CAMERAMAN moves to cover the shot.)

AD: Sheep can step out (motions for SHEEP to leave)

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: (ushering the SHEEP to the side of stage) Let's move over

here, dudes

AD: And move the goat!

FANCY MARY: (walking up in front of JERRY) Excuse me. Goat, go over there. (she

talks firmly in his face) Now...

(LERR) opens his mouth to scream but instead looks scared and tips over.)

MIMI Uh oh! (matter of fact) Jerry tipped over!

TRIXIE: (repeating) Jerry tipped over!

AX walks over to help JERRY up and over to them.)

FLY ANGEL: (admiring) That goat is so fly.

FANCY MARY: (giving up) Whatever. They said to never work with animals.

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: Dudes, we need to be really quiet...

AV 19 (51) (Music begins for "Yonder")


... to film this next scene. Those three actors over there are going to dance in, and lay their gifts in front of baby Jesus.

(BOY BAND WISE MEN dance in.)

TRIXIE: I feel like they need some BAAA-ckup singers...

(TRIXIE and MIMI run up and sing "baaa-ckup.")













AV (*LOOP*: *Celebration Studios Background*)

TRIXIE: (slowly descending into a meltdown) I will admit, while I am loving

the production value, what I do NOT love, is how everyone is treating me like I'm nothing! I am a sheep from the line of

Beatrice Sheepleton, do you understand?

FANCY MARY: (to the DIRECTOR) Excuse me. The sheep are panicking, and it's

throwing me off.

DIRECTOR: (motioning towards TRIXIE) Move the sheep behind the pillar!

AD: Copy that! Sheep behind the pillar!

TRIXIE: (horrified) Not behind the pillar!

(SCOTT THE SHEPHERD starts leading her to stand of stage. SRIXIE digs her heels in and comically resists. SCOTT stops trying when he answers Pax's question.)

PAX: Mr. Shepherd, we are clearly far from home. Can you help us

understand what is happening2

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: (patiently) We are filming a movie about the Christmas

story. We are celebrating the birth of the King!

RAMI: Aha! There IS a king here. How much land does he rule?

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: Not that kind of king.

RAMI: (interrupting) [got it! (looking at his book) Does this king have a

"big, big house, with lots and lots of rooms."

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: (confused) From... the song?

RAMI: What song

SCOTT THE SHEPT ERD: (takes book from RAMI) Oh! This is a book of Christian

songs. They're totally rad.

PAX: (frustrated, to RAMI) Your guidebook was just a book of SONGS?!

TRICE. (fed up) I've had it! What IS this place? There's no grass. Your scrolls are flat. It's never dark, and your shepherds smell like

daisies!

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: Have you never celebrated the birth of Christ?

SHEEP: No...

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: Baby Jesus grew up and died on the cross for our sins.

But the thing is, even though we're sinners, God loved each of us so much. And in sending Jesus, He said that EVERYBODY

MATTERS to Him.

TRIXIE: (still a little miffed) Well, that's nice to know because I'm feeling a

little invisible... and so tired.

RAMI: Would you say you're trying to... (looking down at his book) "find

your place in this world"?

PAX: Not now, Rami.

(SCOTT THE SHEPHERD motions for the SHEEP to circle around him and sit down in a campfire type circle.)

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: What's your shepherd like?

MIMI: He always notices when I get stuck in a bush.

TRIXIE: He makes sure we get lots and lots of rest. And he would care that

my wool-do is deflated.

PAX: He protects us.

RAMI: He's never too busy, and when one of us gets lost, he always goes

out to find us.

AV 110 60 (Music begins for "The Shepherd Knows You Name")

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: It's just like that with Jesus. The Bible says that the

LORD is our Shepherd, and He takes care of us just like that. He

cares about each person.

MIMI: And sheep?


SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: Everyone! You matter to Him.

AVI (LOOP: Celebration Studios Background)

TRIXIE: (super impressed) Wow! This is a REALLY SPECIAL Baby!

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: (nodding) Jesus is like, He's like, OUR Shepherd. He

leads us and guides us. Jesus came to save the world!

PAX: The Baby?

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: (nodding) The Lord. King of EVERYTHING.

TRIXIE: And we discovered Him first! Sheep really ARE the smartest

animals.

MIMI: Let's celebrate this baby King!

RAMI: Let's do it!

(Music begins for "Celebrate this Baby King")

ALL: Yeah!

(There is an immediate BLACKOUT and 1990s CAST suddenly drop to the ground. Now in darkness, or a small spotlight, only the SHEEP stand in a line, squirting toward the audience and calling out into the dark...)



RAMI: Woah! What's going on? What happened to the light?

PAX: Stay together, everyone.

TRIXIE: (tentatively) Fancy Mary?

PAX: (squinting towards front) Mr. Shepherd? Is that you?

(They ALL take a step or two forward then they stop dead in their tracks and ree back from a horrible smell.)

MIMI: Ew! He does *not* smell like daisies anymore.

PAX: HAY! That's definitely OUR shepherd. (smiling) Sheeple...



(Lights come up.)












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

PRODUCTION NOTES

This show is so much fun to produce! The majority of the musical takes place at "Celebration Studios," a 1997 movie studio set. It starts and ends in a Bethlehem field at the time of Jesus' birth, which can be set on a side stage.

CHARACTERS

TRIXIE: Diva sheep

PAX: Gruff sheep; wise, but tired leader

RAMI: Smart sheep—tries to assimilate by lugging around big book

MIMI: Spunky, embarrassed sheep

FANCY MARY: 1990s nativity performer—a bit of a mean girl

AD: 1990s Assistant Director, in charge of the cast

DIRECTOR: No-nonsense. Making a Christmas movie. In charge

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: Friendly boy who understands the sheep when they talk

FLY ANGEL: (few lines) Very trendy and cool angel

JERRY THE YELLING GOAT: Doesn't speak, but partomines to a SFX of a goat yelling,

and tips

JOSEPH: Non-speaking. Stands with Fancy Mary

BOY BAND WISE MEN/CAMELS: Boy Rand performers playing the part of wise men and

camels

CAMERA PERSON: Moves around to capture all the shots on his movie camera

SETTING

A Bethlehem field during the birth of Jesus; Celebration Studios in 1997

THEME

Jesus was born in a manger and grew up to die for our sins. He is our Shepherd and cares for each sheep!

SET

Scene 1 takes place in a Bethlehem field on the night of Christ's birth. Have an empty field with a starry sky, and a rock with a blue light off to the side.

Halfway through Scene 2, the set changes to a movie set in 1997 Calebration Studios. Have two different "sets," a night sky and field, and a stable, feel free to have equipment all over the stage, but move it on one side of the stage while you are "filming" and aiming your cameras at the other side of the stage. So, when the song is about the manger and set in a stable stage left, your director's chair, costume rack, spotlight, cameras, etc. will be stage right.

COSTUMES

TRIXIE: Fuzzy or white sweatpants and shirt, sheep ears, fancy hair

PAX: Fuzzy or white sweatpants and shirt, sheep ears, grey mustache/glasses

RAMI: Fuzzy or white sweatpants and shirt, sheep ears, glasses

MIMI: Fuzzy or white sweatpants and shirt, sheep ears, bow in the hair

FANCY MARY: Traditional Mary costume, possible 1990s flair

AD: All black, possible 1990s flair

DIRECTOR: All black, possible 1990s flair

SCOTT THE SHEPHERD: Traditional shepherd costume, possible 1990s flair

FLY ANGLL: Trendy angel costume

JERRY THE YELLING GOAT: Goat headband and sweats

OSEPH: Traditional costume

BOY BAND WISE MEN: Think very boy band, 1990s, puffy vests, hammer pants,

gold and silver

CAMELS: Camel costume

CAMERA PERSON: All black
